Youth

Allison and 3 youth helped serve 165 meals at the Dinner Bell on July 29th. (Numbers of volunteers were restricted due to COVID-19. (Sponsored by Thrivent and the Benevolence Fund.)

900 Packets with hand sanitizers or tissues, stickers, bookmarks, and information about our church and PDO were given out on 8/6/2020 at the Can Help backpack giveaway.

Rudell (Willingham) Camp Endowment Fund We voted to send half of the funds for 2020 (\$1800) to each of the 2 Lutheran camps our kids have attended—Camp Shiloh and Camp Lone Star in LaGrange. Both can use the funding, and we had no kids interested in camp, and camps were closed all or most of the summer. Joan checked with Legacy Deo, and they said it fell within the guidelines of our agreement.

ReConnect Sunday, usually held the last Sunday in August, has been postponed for at least one month. We are hoping to highlight different activities that are held at the church~quilters, LWML, Men's Club and Breakfast, Choir, Youth Group, Quail Ridge

Sunday School Classes will begin on September 6th, with new, extra safety precautions.

Trunk or Treat is in a "Wait and See" mode as we get closer to that date.

<u>Projector Purchase</u> was discussed due to issues in the past with our old one. Board of Ed has \$500 budgeted for equipment purchases that hasn't been used this year. No research on which one. Making sure no one else was planning to purchase one.

<u>Bulletin Boards</u> Several years ago, we discussed with Council adding a bulletin board between the 2 restrooms for Youth and Missionary info. We have 2 smaller boards available, and would like to hang them soon.

Quail Ridge isn't really a Board of Ed item, but Zulma Deterding is interested in helping again. We may schedule a meeting with volunteers to discuss and decide about beginning class the 2nd week of school (September 8th.)
